

# Carnival Art Kit Step By Step

## Materials

Coloured sugar paper, white paper, white card, hairband, crayons, washi tape, glue stick, a pencil.

**You need to provide: Scissors**

## Costume Headpiece

1. After completing the activity sheet, use your imagination to design and create your headpiece. Decide what shapes you would like to use e.g. rectangular, leaf shape, feather shape. Choose the colours of sugar paper you want to use. Take one sheet at a time and fold in half. Draw out your shape, bigger is better! Cut out the shape, be careful not to cut the fold. Repeat for each piece.
2. Now to attach to the hairband. Taking one shape at a time, put the hairband between the two layers of the shape, on the fold. Using the glue stick, stick the two layers together. Repeat for each shape
3. You add extra detail onto your headpiece by folding paper, twirling it and curling it!
4. Gather your rubbings from your activity sheet. Cut these out and stick them onto your headpiece.
5. Now to strengthen your headpiece we are going to add a backing. Get a sheet of white card, place the hairband on top and trace under the hairband along the spikes. Draw a semi-circle above this line (or any shape you wish it just needs to be big enough to add strength). Cut it out, add glue and attach to the back of your headpiece. Add tape along the outside edge, attaching it to the coloured paper strengthening it.
6. You can also add any other decoration that you might have at home, e.g. feathers, stickers, diamantes etc. Let your creativity flow!
